About the Youth Line

For the last 22 years, the Lesbian Gay Bi Trans Youth Line has been providing confidential, non-judgmental and affirming peer support to lesbian, gay, bi, trans, queer, questioning, 2-spirit, intersex and asexual youth across Ontario. The Youth Line is the first service of its kind and continues to be the only support service of specifically for LGBTQQTT2SIA youth across Ontario.

The Youth Line has over 50 LGBT youth volunteers contributing over **6,000 hours**. We are open 4:00 to 9:30 pm Sunday through Friday evenings and have talked to over **5,000 youth** in the last year by phone, text and chat.

Based in Toronto, the Youth Line has a significant positive impact on the lives of isolated youth that often have no other supports available. We provide peer support, information and referrals to empower youth. Our values of anti-oppression, accessibility and youth leadership are central to all of our work. All of our front-line staff and half of our Board of Directors are LGBT youth themselves.

In 2016, LGBT youth still need the Youth Line. We've seen a **60% increase** in the number of youth who contact us over the last 2 years. Youth come to us because they feel safe, respected and heard. We've been there for the youth of Ontario and will continue to be here for years to come. We cannot do this without our supporters.

About the Craftathon

The LGBT Youth Line is proud to present our second annual Craftathon. Last year's Craftathon was a big success, raising over \$3,500 through individual and small group donations to support LGBTTQQ2SIA youth across Ontario. About 50 people attended the event to make magnets, buttons, greeting cards, knitted bowties and lots more.

Youth Line's Craftathon is growing quickly. There's excitement among our supporters, donors, youth, and volunteers for our 2017 Craftathon activities. We anticipate over 100 attendees and our goal is to raise \$10,000 for LGBT Youth Line's peer support services.

What is the Craftathon?

The Craftathon is an event where people gather for an afternoon to spend time together, learn to craft, make new things for themselves and others, eat food and have fun, all the while raising money to support LGBTQ2S youth across Ontario.

The venue is physically accessible and located in downtown Toronto. There will be gender neutral washrooms, ASL interpretation, and closed captioning.
