

DAN AND PHIL HARD LAUNCH TOUR TICKETS SWEEPSTAKES CONTEST RULES

DAN AND PHIL HARD LAUNCH TOUR TICKETS SWEEPSTAKES (THE “**CONTEST**”) WILL BE CONDUCTED IN THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO ONLY AND SHALL BE CONSTRUED AND EVALUATED ACCORDING TO APPLICABLE CANADIAN LAW. NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY. ENTRANTS MUST BE OF THE AGE OF MAJORITY IN THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO OR OLDER AT THE TIME OF ENTRY. VOID IN WHOLE OR PART WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW. ENTRY IN THIS CONTEST CONSTITUTES ACCEPTANCE OF THESE CONTEST RULES (THE “**CONTEST RULES**”).

1. ELIGIBILITY.

1.1 To be eligible for this Contest, an individual must:

- (a) be a legal resident of the province of Ontario;
- (b) be of the age of majority in the province of Ontario or older at time of entry; and

1.2 The following people are not eligible to enter the Contest:

- (a) Employees of Lesbian Gay Bisexual Trans YouthLine (the “**Organization**”);
- (b) The household members of the parties listed in Section (a) above.

1.3 The Organization shall have the right at any time to require proof of identity and/or eligibility to participate in the Contest. Failure to provide such proof may result in disqualification. All personal and other information requested by and supplied to the Organization for the purpose of the Contest must be truthful, complete, accurate and in no way misleading. The Organization reserves the right, in their sole discretion, to disqualify any entrant should such an entrant at any stage supply information that does not meet these requirements.

2. CONTEST PERIOD. The Contest begins at 9:00 am Eastern Time (“**ET**”) on July 28, 2026 and ends at 11:59 pm ET on September 6, 2026 (the “**Contest Period**”) after which time the Contest will be closed and no further entries shall be accepted.

3. HOW TO ENTER.

3.1 There is no purchase necessary to enter the Contest. Enter using any of the methods of entry outlined below. No entries will be accepted by any other means.

- (a) To enter online, you must visit either <https://www.youthline.ca/danandphil> or <https://www.canadahelps.org/en/dn/148233> (each a “**Contest Microsite**”). Fill out the linked donation form and submit in compliance with the Contest instructions listed on the Contest Microsites to enter the draw for the Prize (defined below) (each, an “**Online Entry**”); and/or
- (b) To enter via mail, send a letter to the Organization’s P.O. Box (address below). The letter can be printed or hand-written. The letter must contain your full name, address, email, phone number, and answer the question “*What do Dan & Phil mean to you?*”. Costs associated with postage must be covered by the sender. Letters received before the end of the Contest Period (each a “**Mailed Entry**”) will be entered the draw for the Prize.

3.2 Limit of ten (10) Online Entries per person, per day. Limit of one (1) Onsite Entry per person, per household. In the case of entries in excess of the stated limit, only the first eligible entries will be considered.

3.3 All entries become the sole property of the Organization and will not be returned for any reason. Entries must be received no later than the end of the Contest Period. Entries will be declared invalid if they are late, illegible, incomplete, damaged, irregular, mutilated, forged, garbled or mechanically or electronically reproduced. Unless otherwise set out herein, no communication or correspondence will be exchanged with entrants except with those selected as a potential winner.

3.4 Entries received online shall be deemed to be submitted by the authorized account holder of the e-mail address associated with the entry. For the purpose of the Contest Rules, “authorized account holder” of an e-mail address is defined as the natural person who is assigned to an e-mail address by an Internet access provider, on-line service provider, or other organization responsible for assigning e-mail addresses for the domain associated with the submitted e-mail address. Any entrant may be required to provide the Organization with proof that they are the authorized account holder of the e-mail address associated with their entry.

4. PRIZES.

- 4.1 There is one (1) prize (the “**Prize**”) available to be won by the prize winner (the “**Winner**”), consisting of the following:
 - (a) Two (2) tickets to the 2026 Dan & Phil Hard Launch tour (the “**Tour**”) performance in Toronto, Ontario on October 9, 2026, at Meridian Hall, 1 Front Street East.
- 4.2 The Prize does NOT include cost related to travel, accommodation, or any other incurred costs for the Winner to attend the Dan & Phil Hard Launch Tour.
- 4.3 The Prize has an approximate value of One Hundred Eighty Canadian dollars (CAD\$180).
- 4.4 Winner is not entitled to monetary difference between actual Prize value and stated approximate Prize value, if any.
- 4.5 The Organization will contact the Winner to coordinate the provision of the Prize within five (5) days once the Winner has been successfully contacted and notified of their Prize and fulfilled the requirements set out herein.

5. PRIZE CONDITIONS.

- 5.1 Prize must be accepted as awarded and cannot be transferred, assigned, substituted or redeemed for cash, except at the sole discretion of the Organization. Any unused, unclaimed or declined portion of the Prize will be forfeited, will have no cash value and the Organization shall have no obligation to provide either an alternative or value-in-kind. The Organization reserves the right, in their sole discretion, to substitute a prize of equal or greater value if the Prize (or any portion thereof) cannot be awarded for any reason.

6. SELECTION.

6.1 One (1) Winner shall be selected as follows:

- (a) On or about September 7, 2026 one (1) entrant will be selected by a random draw from all eligible entries received during the Contest Period. The odds of being selected as a potential winner are dependent upon the number of eligible entries received by the Organization. Before being declared a Winner, each selected entrant shall be required to correctly answer, without assistance of any kind, whether mechanical or otherwise, a time-limited, mathematical skill-testing question to be administered by e-mail to comply with the Contest Rules and to sign and return the Release (described below).
- (b) EACH SELECTED ENTRANT WILL BE NOTIFIED BY E-MAIL NO LATER THAN SEPTEMBER 7, 2026 AT 11:00 am ET AND MUST RESPOND WITHIN TWO (2) BUSINESS DAYS OF NOTIFICATION. Upon notification, the selected entrant must respond by telephone or e-mail (as specified in the notification) to the contact number or e-mail address provided no later than the indicated deadline set out in the Contest Rules and/or the notification. If the selected entrant does not respond accordingly, they will be disqualified and will not receive the Prize and another entrant may be selected in the Organization's sole discretion until such time as an entrant satisfies the terms set out herein. The Organization is not responsible for the failure for any reason whatsoever of a selected entrant to receive notification or for the Organization to receive a selected entrant's response.
- (c) If, as a result of an error relating to the entry process, drawing or any other aspect of the Contest, there are more selected entrants than contemplated in these Contest Rules, there will be a random draw amongst all eligible Prize claimants after the Contest's closing date to award the correct number of Prizes.

7. **RELEASE.** Potential Winner will be required to execute a legal agreement and release (“**Release**”) that confirms potential Winner's: (i) eligibility for the Contest and compliance with these Contest Rules; (ii) acceptance of the Prize as offered; (iii) release of the Organization and their employees, directors, officers, suppliers, agents, sponsors, administrators, licensees, representatives, advertising, media buying and promotional agencies (collectively, the “**Releasees**”) from any and all liability for any loss, harm, damages, cost or expense arising out of participation in the Contest, participation in any Contest-related activity or the acceptance, use, or misuse of any Prize, including but not limited to costs, injuries, losses related to personal injuries, death, damage to, loss or destruction of property, rights of publicity or privacy, defamation, or portrayal in a false light, or from any and all claims of third parties arising therefrom; and (iv) grant to the Organization of the unrestricted right, in the Organization's collective or individual discretion, to produce, reproduce, display, publish, convert, post, serve, broadcast, exhibit, distribute, adapt and otherwise use or re-use the Winner's name, statements, image, likeness, voice and biography, in any and all media now known or hereafter devised, in connection with the Contest and the promotion and exploitation thereof. The executed Release must be returned within five (5) business days of the date indicated on the accompanying letter of notification or the verification as a Winner or the selected entrant will be disqualified and the Prize forfeited.

8. **INDEMNIFICATION BY ENTRANT.** By entering the Contest, each entrant releases, indemnifies and holds Releasees harmless from any and all liability for any injuries, loss or damage of any kind to the entrant or any other person, including personal injury, exposure to the COVID-19 virus, death, or property damage, resulting in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, from (a) their participation in the Contest or any Contest-related activity; (b) the acceptance, use, or misuse of any Prize; or (c) any breach of the Contest Rules. Each entrant agrees to fully indemnify the Releasees from any and all claims made by third parties relating to the entrant's participation in the Contest, without limitation.
9. **LIMITATION OF LIABILITY.** The Organization assumes no responsibility or liability for lost, late, unintelligible/illegible, falsified, damaged, misdirected or incomplete entries, notifications, responses, replies or any Release, or for any computer, online, software, telephone, hardware or technical malfunctions that may occur, including but not limited to malfunctions that may affect the transmission or non-transmission of an entry. The Organization is not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information, whether caused by website users or by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Contest or by any technical or human error which may occur in the administration of the Contest. The Organization assumes no responsibility or liability in the event that the Contest cannot be conducted as planned for any reason, including reasons beyond the control of the Organization, such as infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or corruption of the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this Contest and/or the Contest Microsite.
10. **CONDUCT.** By participating in the Contest, each entrant is deemed to have executed and agrees to be bound by the Contest Rules, which will be posted at the Contest Microsite and made available throughout the Contest Period. Each entrant further agrees to be bound by the decisions of the Organization, which shall be final and binding in all respects. The Organization reserves the right, in their sole discretion, to disqualify any entrant found to be: (a) violating the Contest Rules; (b) tampering or attempting to tamper with the entry process or the operation of the Contest and/or the Contest Microsite or any related promotional website; (c) violating the terms of service, conditions of use and/or general rules or guidelines of any property of the Organization or service; and/or (d) acting in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner, or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass the Organization or any other person. CAUTION: ANY ATTEMPT TO DELIBERATELY DAMAGE THE CONTEST MICROSITE OR ANY RELATED WEBSITE OR UNDERMINE THE LEGITIMATE OPERATION OF THE CONTEST MAY BE A VIOLATION OF CRIMINAL AND CIVIL LAWS. SHOULD SUCH AN ATTEMPT BE MADE, THE ORGANIZATION RESERVES THE RIGHT TO SEEK REMEDIES AND DAMAGES TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO CRIMINAL PROSECUTION.
11. **PRIVACY / USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION.**
- 11.1 By entering the Contest, each entrant expressly consents to the Organization to collect, use, store, and share any personal information submitted by entrant to enter the Contest, such as name, age of majority confirmation, and contact information, as applicable, only for the purpose of implementing, administering, and fulfilling the Contest as described in these Contest Rules.
- 11.2 Each Winner further consents that: (a) any personal information they have provided in connection with this Contest may be shared with prize providers for the purpose of facilitating the delivery or fulfillment of a Prize; and (b) the Organization may broadcast, publish, disseminate and otherwise use a Winner's name, city/town/village and province/territory of residence, image and/or voice in connection with any promotion and/or publicity purposes without further compensation to Winner.

11.3 No communication unrelated to the Contest, commercial or otherwise, will be sent to the entrant unless the entrant otherwise expressly agrees to receive further communications from the Organization.

12. **INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY.** All intellectual property, including but not limited to trade-marks, trade names, logos, designs, promotional materials, web pages, source code, drawings, illustrations, slogans and representations is owned by the Organization and/or their affiliates. All rights are reserved. Unauthorized copying or use of any copyrighted material or intellectual property without the express written consent of its owner is strictly prohibited.
13. **TERMINATION.** The Organization reserves the right, in their sole discretion, to terminate the Contest, in whole or in part, and/or modify, amend or suspend the Contest, and/or the Contest Rules in any way, at any time, for any reason without prior notice.
14. **LAW.** These are the official Contest Rules. The Contest is subject to applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws and regulations. The Contest Rules are subject to change without notice in order to comply with any applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws or the policy of any other entity having jurisdiction over the Organization. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of the Contest Rules or the rights and obligations as between the entrant and the Organization in connection with the Contest shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the province of Ontario without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules or provisions that would cause the application of any other jurisdiction's laws.
15. **DISCREPANCY.** In the event of any discrepancy or inconsistency between the terms and conditions of the Contest Rules and disclosures or other statements contained in any Contest-related materials, including but not limited to the Contest entry form, or point of sale, television, print or online advertising, the terms and conditions of the Contest Rules shall prevail, govern and control.
16. **SOCIAL MEDIA.** This Contest is in no way sponsored, endorsed or administered by any social media platforms on which the Contest may have been promoted and/or publicized. Any questions, comments or complaints regarding the Contest must be directed to the Organization.
17. **INDEPENDENT OF TOUR.** This Contest is in no way sponsored, endorsed or administered in any way by the Tour, its owners, operators, agents, contractors or others associated in any way with the Tour.
