About LGBT YouthLine

Lesbian Gay Bi Trans YouthLine is a 2SLGBTQ+ youth-led organization that affirms and supports the experiences of youth (29 & under) across Ontario. We do this by:

- Providing anonymous peer support & referrals;
- Training youth to provide support to other youth; &
- Providing resources so that youth can make informed decisions.

About the Board of Directors

Our Board works with the YouthLine Executive Director, staff, and volunteers to fulfill our mission and vision. As a Board Member, you will participate in a wide range of activities including:

- Attending and participating in monthly board meetings
- Policy writing, research, and review
- Representing the organization at public events
- Participating in and leading fundraising initiatives
- Planning for the future of the organization (Youthline is currently undergoing an organizational review and will be implementing feedback regarding the organizational structure and operations. Experience with change management and organizational psychology would be an asset)
- Chairing and sitting on various committees (finance, policy, governance, fundraising, etc.)

Board Members are required to serve a **minimum of one 2-year term**, with an average monthly commitment of 15 to 20 hours. Hours include attendance at our monthly board meetings on the last Wednesday evening of each month, participation in two working groups, and supporting and attending YouthLine events.

Who We're Looking For:

As a **2SLGBTQ+** youth-led organization, we especially encourage youth members (18-29) to apply for consideration. Interested candidates should expect to commit at least **15 to 20 hours per month** to YouthLine matters over a **2-year term**.

LGBT YouthLine only considers applicants that identify as part of the 2SLGBTQ+ community.

In line with YouthLine's provincial mandate, we are particularly interested in candidates from outside the Greater Toronto Area. The board meets and operates virtually.

Grounded in principles of Anti-Racism and Anti-Oppression, we recognize and encourage applications from communities that are further marginalized, including: Black, Indigenous and people of colour, Trans-feminine people, Persons with disabilities, people with experiences of migration, and people who have experiences of poverty. **Applicants are encouraged to self-identify in their applications, which will be kept confidential.**

Special consideration will be given to candidates who have existing skills or a strong interest in building experience in the following areas:

- Board Leadership
- Fundraising and Development (campaigns, donor stewardship and engagement etc.)
- Finance

Note: Candidates should have an understanding of power dynamics and colonial structures and be prepared to navigate these in a board setting.

Volunteer Environment and Expectations:

- Volunteer Time Commitment: 15 to 20 hours per month.
- Location: Remote, home-based position.
- Access Needs: Access to reliable internet is required. While YouthLine is a digital-first organization, this position may require occasional (i.e. 1-2 times a year) travel within Ontario.
