WHO ARE WE?





- (1) Providing anonymous peer support and referrals
- (2) Training youth to provide support to other youth
- (3) Providing resources so youth can make informed decisions



The Provincial Youth Ambassador Project (PYAP) is a LGBT YouthLine program that brings together 2SLGBTQ+ youth from across the province to increase 2SLGBTQ+ programming and supports in their local regions, strengthen leadership skills, and build networks amongst 2SLGBTQ+ youth. Funding for this project made possible by the Government of Canada under the Canada Service Corps program.









Everyone is different and that should be celebrated!



The term "intersectionality" was coined by Kimberlé Crenshaw


